### From the Pastor's Pen

Can This Be?

As I write this, I am aware that weather predictions made today for the next several days will have "come and gone" by the time you read this. But for now, and having just watched the local weather forecast, I ask, "Can This Be?". Will the forecast materialize with freezing rain and snow?

Remember, a few weeks ago, as weekupon-week of warm weather came and went, we asked, "Can this Be?". Somehow, after years of experiencing Charlotte-area winters, we knew that the cold of winter had to come. But as we

-normal days, we asked, "Can This Be?". And ironically, now that winter has arrived with projected ice and snow, I find myself asking, "Can This Be?".

My question, however, is now directed to the accuracy of the forecast. Yes, winter has finally arrived, but will the icy/snowy mix be as severe as the forecasters predict? Again, "Can This Be?". The answer will be known by the time you read this.

This "Can This Be?" question is one that has been asked for centuries. Prophesies or forecasts bring forth expectations and a sensitivity to time and awareness. For example, let's consider the gospel accounts of Jesus' life on earth. For hundreds of years before the incarnate birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, the prophets (forecasters of the Messiah) had predicted that God would send a Savior to the world. And while Jesus walked, waited, as we enjoyed those warmer-than talked, and healed while living here,

many asked, "Can This Be?".

And today, this "Can This Be?" question concerning the Gospel of Jesus continues for those who have heard the stories of Jesus. For those who know of Jesus, "Can This Be?" is answered "yes" by true Christians; "maybe" by seekers; and "no" by modern-day pagans. But what about those who have not heard about Jesus? Sadly, it seems that more people in our day and time are more interested in talking about the weather than in talking about Jesus. They have heard the weather forecast, but have they heard about Jesus Christ? Let us as Christians and members of Oak Grove share the Good News of Jesus. Our Savior is no longer a forecast. We know He lives! Let none of us question and ask, "Can This Be?".


